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Parent and/or Guardian/Citizen Involvement in Education

The NJSBA believes that local boards of education should promote parent and/or guardian/citizen involvement in education. Schools should be made accessible to parents and members of the community; opportunities for communication among staff, parents and/or guardians, and the general public should be encouraged; school-related policies and procedures, data and other information should be provided; parents and/or guardians and citizens should be involved in the development of policies and programs; and parents and/or guardians and citizens should be provided meaningful participation, within reasonable parameters, at all regular public board meetings.
