Time, Place, Notification of Meetings



Timing, Notification and Agenda of School Board Meetings

- A. **The NJSBA believes** that boards should be permitted to commence their meetings no later than 9:00 p.m. [Authority: DA 5/69-21; DA 11/98-SR]
- B. The NJSBA believes each local school district should have the option of holding its organization meeting on any day of the first two weeks following the April school election. [Authority: DA 12/85-3; DA 11/98-SR]
- C. **The NJSBA believes** that any notification and agenda requirements for school board meetings should effectuate a balance between the public's right to attend board meetings and the board's need to conduct its business efficiently, and without unreasonable delay or undue expense or administrative burden. [*Authority*: BD 4/93]
- D. The NJSBA believes that advisory committees should not be subject to notification, agenda or other requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act. [Authority: BD 4/93, DA 5/03-SR, DA 5/08-SR, DA 5/13-SR]
